




#### Fira Barcelona - Gran Via

Gran Via Fira is one of the largest and most modern venues in Europe, designed by the Japanese architect Toyo Ito.

#### Barcelona International Convention Centre



Numbers of February 2017: Barcelona city & region









# Barcelona, city of culture


