

2,000 years of history

- Cultural heritage: a mixture of coexisting civilizations.
- The Roman Barcino and Baetulo, temple of Augustus and the Roman aqueduct by the Praetorian Gate.
- Medieval heritage: the Romanesque religious site of Egara in Terrassa, the Gothic and Jewish neighbourhoods in the centre of Barcelona, and the Gothic quarters in Manresa and Cardona.
- · Contemporary architecture.



Modernisme (Catalan art nouveau)

- Civil and industrial architecture: some examples are the Casa Batlló, the Palau de la Música Catalana, the Casa Amatller, the Colonia Güell, the *modernista* legacy of Canet de Mar and the *modernista* wineries, also known as "wine cathedrals".
- 9 modernista buildings declared World Heritage sites by UNESCO.
- Famous modernista architects: Antoni Gaudí, Josep Puig i Cadafalch, Lluís Domènech i Montaner.
